Labor Day Cookies

Let your church know that you appreciate their hard work with a Labor Day Cookie. These cookies are very easy and fun to make and are perfect to show your appreciation.

Need:

- Pillsbury Refrigerated Cookie Dough – Sugar Cookie Flavor
- Icing
- Edible Writing Icing
- Popsicle Sticks (Enough for however many cookies you are making)

Instructions:

1. Prepare the sugar cookies according to the instructions on the tube.
2. Immediately after you remove the cookies from the oven, place one popsicle stick into each cookie, and allow the cookie to cool with popsicle stick inside of it.
3. Once the cookies are cool you can decorate! Get creative using candies and writing icing. Give each Sunday School child a different color of vanilla icing to use (add food coloring to the icing).
4. Write "Thank You", "Job Well Done", or "Thanks" on the cookies using an edible writing icing.
5. Have each Sunday School child give their cookie to someone special to let them know how much they are appreciated on this Labor Day!

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Labor Day Helping Hands

Have your Sunday School children show their appreciation this Labor Day by offering someone a helping hand. Not only will others appreciate the gesture but they'll cherish this wonderful handprint kids craft.

Need:

- Construction Paper (White or Light-Colored)
- Scissors
- Markers or Crayons

Instructions:

1. Have your Sunday School children trace their hand on a piece of construction paper.
2. Use scissors to cut out the handprint.
3. Decorate one side of the handprint.
4. On the other side of the hand, write something such as:
 - a. "Here is a helping hand in case you ever need it."
 - b. "I appreciate your helping hand."
 - c. "Thank you for your helping hand."

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Labor Day Game

Your Sunday School children or you and your family will have a blast playing this Labor Day game. All you need to get started is a few items that you can usually find around the house and you are set for hours of fun and excitement.

Need:

- Sheets of Paper (any kind of paper)
- Pencil or Pen
- Bowl
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. On a blank sheet of paper, have your Sunday School children write down different jobs that people have. Example: Police officer, veterinarian, firefighter, pastor, grocery clerk, secretary, etc.
2. Have them cut out the different jobs and place them in a bowl.
3. Have one of the Sunday School children pick one piece of paper from the bowl. Without the other person seeing what they picked, have them draw a picture of the job they picked out. Have them keep drawing clues until someone guesses the image that was drawn.
4. Have the child that guesses the image or job draw a piece of paper out of the bowl and repeat the steps above.
5. Make sure every child gets a turn in the drawing.
