

YOUTH CAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No camper will be permitted to leave the campground without permission from the camp director.
2. Swimming is only allowed in the pool during scheduled times and under lifeguard supervision. Absolutely no swimming, fishing or wading will be allowed in the lake.
3. Conduct and speech exhibited at camp must be in keeping with Christian principles.
4. The use of alcohol, or tobacco products of any kind are absolutely forbidden.
5. **Clothing worn at camp shall be in accordance with modest Christian attire. The camp director and staff can and will decide if the clothing is appropriate. Campers will be asked to change his or her clothes if they are deemed inappropriate.** Inappropriate items include spaghetti straps, mid-riff/belly shirts, backless and strapless tops and cheerleading shorts. A rule of thumb is that all shorts should come below your fingertips when your arms are resting at your side. Skirts and dresses must be knee length.
6. Clothing that is offensive or advertises alcoholic beverages, drinking establishments, tobacco or rock music is forbidden.
7. Male campers must keep their shirts on at all times except when inside the fence at the pool.
8. One-piece bathing suits only. Two-piece bathing suits may be worn when covered with a dark t-shirt.
9. Due to our busy daily schedule and required camper participation we discourage visitation. **Visitation (including parents) is limited to the evening service, which begins at __:__ p.m.**
10. CD players, ipods, MP3 players, cell phones, televisions, refrigerators, etc. are not allowed. (Appropriate music may be allowed for skits, talent show, or special music, but must be approved and music players will be provided by counselors).
11. All phone calls (incoming and outgoing) will be limited to the hours of 2:30 and 5:00 P.M. Any other phone calls must be an emergency and approved by a counselor.
12. **All camp rules will be enforced. The camp director retains the right to send any camper home who refuses to adhere to camp rules.**
