Not Allowed: Camp policies do not permit alcohol, guns, knives, and any item in an aerosol can.

Dress Code: Volunteers will wear clothing appropriate for camp. Sandals and flip flops are allowed for everyday and non-sport activities. No flip flops allowed in church services. Sneakers are mandatory for sports activities. Shirts and T-Shirts can be worn but any messages must be Christian related.
